



A Message from your School Nurse

Dear Parent:

If your child will need medication during the school year, please fill out the parent form and have your doctor complete the physician form. All parental, emergency and physician statements must be renewed each August. These forms must be returned in person by the parent or guardian, before medications can be administered at school.

Only oral, pre-measured inhalants and topical diaper rash medicine can be administered by school staff. Medication, as it applied to school, includes all prescription and over the counter preparations.

Attached is a copy of the CPSB policy on the medication and the two forms. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. We hope this will help eliminate some confusion about medication at the beginning of each school year.

Ref: R.S. 17:436.1 Relative to the administration of medication by the school employees.

The following is required to accept Medication at the school.

- 1. Completed Medication Order (with physician's signature and date)**
- 2. Completed Parent Consent Form (with parent/guardian's signature & date)**
- 3. Pharmacy Labeled Medication (Prescription or Over the Counter)**
- 4. Adult must bring Medication to School Office.**
